- -your contact information

- -Additional skills

Don't pad! It is always obvious and will often turn off potential employers. At this point in your career, we all expect you won't have enough experience to fill out a huge resume. That's not the point. The point is to take a long, hard look at what you have done and own it.

Think carefully about how you are presenting yourself. What will make you stand out from all those others?
